Foreword:

Breastfeeding is uniquely a right of women and they should be supported by society to breastfeed. Men and other women and young people can assist mothers and mother support groups to continue breast feeding exclusively up to six months and thereafter with home-made complimentary foods up to 2 years. With the view of ensuring breastfeeding, World Breastfeeding Week (WBW) has been organized since 1992 in Bangladesh by Bangladesh Breastfeeding Foundation in collaboration with Ministry of Health and family welfare and Institute of Public Health Nutrition (IPHN). This year's theme of WBW is as "Empower parents, enable breastfeeding: Now and for the future!" যার বাংলা মর্মার্থ দাঁড়ায়, "শিশুকে মাতৃদুগ্ধ পান করাতে মাতা-পিতাকে উৎসাহিত করুন"

Breastfeeding is a vital part of sustainable development and a non-negotiable component of global action to end malnutrition. Increased rates of exclusive and continued breastfeeding can only be achieved by cooperating and collaborating across sectors and generations. Concerted action is needed to achieve the World Health Assembly (WHA) target of at least 50% exclusive breastfeeding by 2025. While significant progress has been made, a lot of work remains to be done to close the gap between policies and implementation. World Breastfeeding Week (WBW) has been organized since 1992 in Bangladesh by Bangladesh Breastfeeding Foundation in collaboration with Ministry of Health and family welfare (MOH&FW) and Institute of Public Health Nutrition (IPHN). In 2009 the Honorable Prime Minister of Bangladesh inaugurated the WBW and declared that BBF will jointly work with Ministry of Health & Family Welfare in the area of Breastfeeding, Complementary Feeding & Maternal Nutrition activities. By the declaration of the Honorable Prime Minister, WBW has been observed as a National Event for last nine years and BBF has the honor to be the key partner in organizing all the events along with MOH&FW and IPHN.

I am assertive that information contained in this report will enable us to achieve a better and more sustainable development in Bangladesh and to prioritize breastfeeding.

Preamble:

In Bangladesh, World Breastfeeding Week(1-7 August) 2019 has been observed by the Bangladesh Breastfeeding Foundation in collaboration with MoHFW since 1992. This year's theme for World Breast Feeding Week is- "Empower parents, enable breastfeeding: Now and for the future!" যার বাংলা মর্মার্থ দাঁড়ায়, "শিশুকে মাতৃদুগ্ধ পান করাতে মাতা-পিতাকে উৎসাহিত করুন" to achieve SDGs.

WBW 2019 celebrates working together for the common theme "Empower parents, enable breastfeeding: Now and for the future!" Research shows that paid maternity leave policies could help reduce infant mortality by 13% for each additional month of maternity leave. Paid leave enables women to physically recover from childbirth before returning to work and benefits their physical, mental and emotional health in the short- and long-term. Policies that ensure parental and paternity leave should not compromise existing maternity leave benefits or leave availability.

According to the International Labor Organization (ILO), more than 830 million women workers do not have adequate maternity protection. Of approximately 170 countries studied, paternity and parental leave are available in only 78 and 66 countries respectively. Most countries offer at least some paid maternity leave.

The inauguration ceremony of WBW 2019 was held at Bangabandhu International Conference Centre (BICC) on 6th August and Honorable Health Minister of Peoples Republic of Bangladesh inaugurated the WBW 2019 to encourage celebrating the WBW with active participation. His presence brought all possible support to make the event successful and make further advancement in Infant and young child feeding (IYCF) movement in Bangladesh. This year, an essay & Art competition was organized to celebrate the week. A 'Breastfeeding and Nutrition fair' was also arranged during the inauguration.

Like every year World Breastfeeding Week was celebrated all over the Countries. Medical College both government and non-government Hospitals, different government and non-government organizations, Community clinic, stakeholders and UN agencies organized seminar, workshop, art Competition, essay competition and nutrition fair.

Though we have achieved a lot, there is still need to do a lot. We are confident that this report will stimulate better informed people about the new Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and how they relate to breastfeeding and Infant and Young Child Feeding (IYCF). Thus firmly anchor breastfeeding as a key component of sustainable development throughout the Bangladesh.

- Leaflets and posters will be prepared and distributed in light of the theme
 content of World Breastfeeding Week.
- 5. A request letter will be provided to the concerned divisional, district, upazila and community level senior officials, along with a program plan to commemorate World Breastfeeding Week at the divisional, district, upazila and community levels.
- 6. The discussion and debate contests will be organized for the adolescents through the club for the benefit of breastfeeding, the harmful side effects of breast milk alternatives, the Breast-Milk Substitutes Act, 2013.
- 7. In order to increase the enthusiasm among the students and promote World Breastfeeding Week, the number of prizes will be increased in essay competition.

8. In any case, in the divisional or district or upazila or community, more than one institution will not do the same activities at the same level.

- 10. In case of educational institutions, IEC materials will be sent at the central level and at the proportional rate at the district and upazila level.
- 11. The theme must be finalized in to Bengali of the World Breastfeeding Week. In this case, Bangla Theme will also be taken into consideration in the certification received from the stakeholders.

12. All mosques, temples, churches and monasteries and various occupations will be incorporated and necessary arrangements will be taken to promote the celebration of this year's World Breastfeeding Week.

The ceremony was ended followed by the visit of Honorable Health Minister to 23 exhibition stalls with various strategies of improvement in IYCF and Nutrition displayed by stakeholders of IYCF with Govt and Non Govt organisations.



Brief Report on Celebration of WBW' 19 at the Community Clinic:

Community Based Health Care (CBHC) of Bangladesh under the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) is the innovation of Hon'ble Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to extend Primary Health Care to the doorsteps of rural people all over rural Bangladesh. There are 13,600 community clinics (CCs) for every 6000 population across the country brings health, family planning and nutrition services under one roof and within half-an-hour walking distance from their homes, even in remote areas.

This is the 3rd time that WBW was observed successfully through CBHC in a focused way. In this regards, Line Director, NNS issued a request letter to CBHC and thereafter, the Line Director, CBHC gave ordered to celebrate the WBW in Community Clinic.

According to the work plan of WBW'19, each community clinic was ordered to collect supplied IEC materials from respective Civil Surgeon Office. This activity was funded under OP of IPHN.




